I am in receipt of your September 13, 2007 comment letter regarding the Application for the Franchise Registration of the We The People LLC. Below are the responses as numbered in your comment letter.

- 1. Item 5 has been revised to state that "you must become a Notary Public".
- Item 3 does contain the Consent and Desist Order with the Minnesota Commissioner of Commerce.

I did not include this Consent with the Consents listed in Item 1 of the Offering Circular because these Consent Orders deal with the operation of the franchised document preparation business and specifically with the franchisees. The Consent and Desist Order is listed prior to the concluded Litigation in WTP's Offering Circular (page 9). I trust that you will find this satisfactory.

- Legalese language has been removed.
- 4. Minnesota Addendums to the Offering Circular and Franchise Agreement have been added to include the following:
 - 5. Governing Law, Jurisdiction and Venue and Choice of Forum
 - 6. Compliance with the termination, cure and non renewal time periods
 - 7. Trademarks and the franchisee's right to use the trademarks
 - 8. Prohibition on the franchisor's requirement of a general release
 - 9. Waiver of a Jury Trial
 - 10. Limitations of Claims
 - 11. Injunctive Relief

A copy of the redlined pages relating to the above comments as well as the applicable Minnesota Addendums is herein included for your review. I trust that these fulfill the requirements set out in your Comment Letter.
