As a franchisee, you operate a "Weathersby Guild" franchised business that offers furniture repair and restoration services under the name WEATHERSBY GUILD.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a WEATHERSBY GUILD franchised business ranges from \$62,090 to \$88,630. This includes an initial fee of \$39,500 that must be paid to the franchisor.

OUT OF STATE ARBITRATION MIGHT FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MIGHT ALSO COST YOU MORE TO ENGAGE IN OUR HOME STATE THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE.
