Weathersby Guild

As a franchisee, you operate a "Weathersby Guild" franchised business that offers furniture repair and restoration services under the name WEATHERSBY GUILD.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a WEATHERSBY GUILD franchised business ranges from \$51,590 to \$93,130. This includes an initial fee of \$39,000 to \$44,000 that must be paid to the franchisor.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale or grant. Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. The information in this disclosure document can help you make up your mind. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO SUBMIT ALL DISPUTES YOU MAY HAVE AGAINST US (EXCEPT FOR ANY CLAIMS FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF PENDING ARBITRATION) TO BINDING ARBITRATION IN GWINNETT COUNTY, GEORGIA. OUT OF STATE ARBITRATION OR LITIGATION MIGHT FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MIGHT ALSO COST YOU MORE TO ARBITRATE OR LITIGATE IN OUR HOME STATE THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE. SOME STATE FRANCHISE LAWS PROVIDE THAT CHOICE OF FORUM PROVISIONS IS VOID OR SUPERSEDED. YOU MIGHT WANT TO INVESTIGATE WHETHER YOU ARE PROTECTED BY A STATE FRANCHISE LAW.
