The franchise offered is for the operation of a business providing various services and products under several distinct categories; window cleaning, window tinting, pressure washing, window blinds and solar shades, tile & grout cleaning and sealing, gutter protection and related ancillary services, including concrete and brick cleaning and sealing, house washing and gutter cleaning for the residential and commercial markets under the trade name "Window Genie[®]."

The total investment (exclusive of office rental costs, if any) necessary to begin operation of a single unit Window Genie[®] franchise ranges from \$81,250 to \$131,100. This includes a base marketing area up to approximately 50,000 households. You may purchase up to an additional 50,000 households in a geographic area contiguous to the base marketing area for fifty cents (\$.50) per household.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

- 1. MANY FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS DO NOT ALLOW YOU TO RENEW UNCONDITIONALLY AFTER THE INITIAL TERM EXPIRES. YOU MAY HAVE TO SIGN A NEW AGREEMENT WITH DIFFERENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN ORDER TO CONTINUE TO OPERATE YOUR BUSINESS. BEFORE YOU BUY, CONSIDER WHAT RIGHTS YOU HAVE TO RENEW YOUR FRANCHISE, IF ANY, AND WHAT TERMS YOU MIGHT HAVE TO ACCEPT IN ORDER TO RENEW.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT PERMITS YOU TO SUE ONLY IN HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO. OUT OF STATE LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT. IT MAY ALSO COST MORE TO LITIGATE WITH US IN OHIO THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE. THIS PROVISION MAY BE SUPERSEDED BY CERTAIN STATE LAWS. PLEASE REFER TO THE STATE SPECIFIC ADDENDA ATTACHED TO THIS DISCLOSURE DOCUMENT.
- 3. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT PROVIDES THAT OHIO LAW GOVERNS THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS. THIS PROVISION MAY BE SUPERSEDED BY CERTAIN STATE LAWS. PLEASE REFER TO THE STATE SPECIFIC ADDENDA ATTACHED TO THIS DISCLOSURE DOCUMENT.
- 4. YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO MAKE AN ESTIMATED INITIAL INVESTMENT RANGING FROM \$81,250 to \$131,100 TO BEGIN OPERATION OF A SINGLE UNIT WINDOW GENIE[®] FRANCHISE. THESE AMOUNTS EXCEED THE FRANCHISOR'S MEMBERSHIP EQUITY AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2012, WHICH WAS A NEGATIVE ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS (-\$131,622.00).
- 5. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.

We use the services of ten or more MASTER FRANCHISES AND FRANCHISE BROKERS or referral sources to assist us in selling our franchise. A franchise broker or referral source represents us, not you. We pay this person a fee for selling our franchise or referring you to us. You should be sure to do your own investigation of the franchise.
