\$20,000

WOOPS' SHOP

\$35,000

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a **WOOPS' MOBILE BUSINESS** franchised business is between **\$69,800** and **\$111,050** This includes the initial fees of **\$20,000** that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s)

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a **WOOPS' SHOP** franchised business is between **\$199,800** and **\$348,500** This includes the initial fees of **\$35,000** that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s)

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements and documents carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale.
