As a Yi Fang Taiwan Fruit Tea franchisee, you will operate a retail food establishment that sells items from a focused menu featuring a variety of teas and juice drinks, using proprietary teas, milk teas and juices, tapioca balls, recipes and preparation techniques, freshly prepared and available for carry-out or consumption on the premises.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Yi Fang Taiwan Fruit Tea franchised business is \$118,700 to \$221,250 for a single outlet. This includes \$37,500 to \$50,750 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliates. If you become an Area Developer of Yi Fang Taiwan Fruit Tea franchised business, the total investment will range from \$308,700 to \$411,250. This includes development fee of \$190,000 that must be paid to the franchisor.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
