The franchisee will operate a retail sales and installation business selling custom closets, garage cabinets and other organizers within a designated territory. The total investment necessary to begin operation of Closets by Design franchise is \$126,000 to \$296,500 (not including real property). This includes \$38,000 to \$73,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliates.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
