The ZEROREZ regional developer franchisee will operate a business that will provide technical marketing and sales support services to a number of ZEROREZ franchisees engaged in complete carpet floor fabric care and living surfaces cleaning services including upholstery, fabrics hard surfaces floors air duct cleaning and air filters within a specific territory granted to the regional developer in exchange for service fees

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a ZEROREZ regional developer franchise is \$115,500 to \$514,000. This includes \$115,000 to \$500,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate

This Disclosure Document (referred to herein sometimes as the or this Disclosure Document) summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully.
