We offer qualified individuals and entities a franchise for the right to independently own and operate a gourmet coffee and tea retail store and café (each, a “Café” or “Sweetwaters Location”) utilizing our proprietary marks, including the mark SWEETWATERS, and the proprietary business system that we have developed. We also offer qualified parties the right to own and operate multiple Cafés within a development area that we designate.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a single Café is \$264,144 to \$636,038. This includes \$59,500 to \$64,400 that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate prior to opening.

The total investment necessary to operate multiple Cafés under our form of area development agreement depends on the number of franchises we grant you the right to open. By way of example, the estimated initial investment to develop (i) two (2) Cafés is \$284,144 to \$656,038; (ii) three (3) Cafés \$314,144 to \$686,038; and (iv) five (5) Cafés is \$364,144 to \$736,038. These estimate ranges include the estimated initial investment to open your first Café within your permitted site selection area, as well as a development fee that you must pay to us amounting to (a) \$69,500 for two (2) Cafés, (b) \$99,500 for three (3) Cafés, or (c) \$149,500 for five (5) Cafés.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
